#### PROJECTS COMPLETED DURING THE PAST 3 YEARS:

- ✓ Entry sign at the corner of Hwy 48 and Ft. Stanton
- ✓ Purchased benches for Alto and Outlaw golf courses
- ✓ Purchased outdoor umbrellas for ACC
- ✓ Sponsored a CPR Class for Alto members
- ✓ Hosted member activities in conjunction with Alto's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary (face painting/jumping castle)
- ✓ Set up a lending library at Alto
- ✓ Purchased 4 defibrillators for Alto clubhouse
- ✓ Repainted the stucco sign on High Mesa and French St.
- ✓ Contributed to the purchase and installation of a flagpole at Outlaw during the July 4, 2018 parade and festivities

#### ONGOING ANNUAL PROJECTS:

- ✓ Host Bingo nights semi-annually to support Alto Employee Scholarship Program (donated \$2,445 in 2018, plus \$1,087 thus far in 2019)
- ✓ Provide tanks of vinegar for control of thistles
- ✓ Maintain neighborhood signage such as emergency evacuation routes
- ✓ Sponsor a Mile on Hwy 48 at the entrance to Alto and hold trash pickup days semiannually
- ✓ Host informative meetings for Alto members
- ✓ Keep ALPOA members informed through a member-wide E-mail blast
- ✓ Donate to local charities (paid out \$6,500 in 2018)
- ✓ Support Alto Employees through donations to their Employee Appreciation Fund
- ✓ Donate funds to Alto projects as opportunities arise
